

Donation of Securities to Army Emergency Relief

Contributors who wish to donate securities to Army Emergency Relief should follow one of these two procedures, depending upon how the donor holds the securities:

For securities held in brokerage accounts:

The broker should be directed to transfer the securities to Army Emergency Relief through the Depository Trust Company, using DTC number 2669. The transfer should be made to Army Emergency Relief, reference account number 26-03984 with The Northern Trust Company, Chicago, IL.

For Securities held by the donor in certificate form:

The certificates should be properly executed for transfer, using Medallion Signature Guarantee (or equivalent is permitted by the issuing company) and shipped via registered USPS mail to:

[Please DO NOT mail the certificates to Army Emergency Relief offices.]

The instructions accompanying the certificates should direct that they be placed in Army Emergency Relief account number 26-03984.

Regardless of which method is used, we would appreciate receiving the transfer information from the donor or the broker so that we can alert The Northern Trust Company of the pending transfer.

All donations will be acknowledged and donors will be provided with documentation necessary for tax reporting purposes. Donations will be valued at the mean market value on the day they are posted to Army Emergency Relief's account by The Northern Trust Company.
